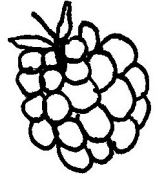


ESTIVATION: the act of spending or passing the summer

home:

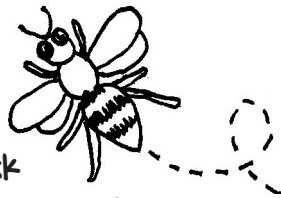


- Grow something from a seed.

- Visit a national park and write about it in your journal. Include photos, drawings, specimens, maps, etc.

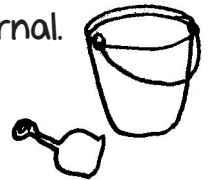
Bees:
